SEEDLINGS MISSION: SEEDLINGS BRAILLE BOOKS FOR CHILDREN is a nonprofit, 501(c)3 tax-exempt organization dedicated to increasing the opportunity for literacy by providing high-quality, low-cost children's literature in braille.

SEEDLINGS HISTORY: In 1984 when Debra Bonde founded Seedlings, braille materials were scarce and expensive. Her goals were to increase the availability and lower the cost of braille books for children, thereby promoting their literacy skills and their love of reading. In 1985, the first year of book production, Debra made 221 books in the basement of her house. During the past year, with the help of a small staff and many loyal volunteers and donors, Seedlings produced a record 32,254 braille books and articles, making a grand total of 477,082 since 1984.

2016 was the Best Year Yet!



- Record braille book distribution: 32,254 up 21% over 2015.

In 2016, over 32,000 braille books & articles were printed, assembled, & shipped from our small office in Livonia, MI

Approximately half of these materials were purchased by schools, agencies, libraries, and families for an average of only \$10 each (traditionally braille books were VERY expensive!) This was made possible by our dedicated donors, volunteers, and staff.

BOOK ANGEL PROGRAM: 3 Free Books per Child for use at Home

Background: This program was created in loving memory of Anna K. Bonde, our Director's daughter. The purpose is to enable blind children to receive three free books per year to help promote their



Funding: This program is funded by grants, bequests, and donations.

Number Distributed: In 2016, a record 5940 "Angel Books" were made and distributed to children across the US & Canada. More than 38,300 free braille books have been placed into children's hands since this program began in 2002.

THE ROSE PROJECT: Free Braille Encyclopedia Articles



Background: In 1994 when we realized that blind children did not have access to braille encyclopedias, we launched the Rose Project which allows children to request free encyclopedia articles in braille.

Funding: This program was originally funded by a bequest from a woman named Rose (hence the name of the project) and is now funded by gifts from our donors.

Number Distributed: In 2016, transcribed and distributed 182 free braille encyclopedia articles to children. Since the program began, over 10,200 articles have been sent to children to assist them with their studies.

SEEDLINGS' ADOPT-A-READER PROGRAM

We believe that in order to be life-long readers, children need to be surrounded with books, but sometimes families need help with this. Consequently we started this program in Michigan in 2011. It has since expanded to Ohio and Illinois. In 2016, 506 books were given to the children who were "adopted" by our generous donors. Each donor gave \$100 which allowed "their child" to pick out \$100's worth of free books. Over 2300 free books have been donated to children since the program began.

FREE BOOKS FOR TEACHERS

Background: Teachers of Students with Visual Impairments dedicate their lives to bringing the gift of literacy to blind children. They often have very few braille materials, so when we receive gifts, grants, and beguests, we try to use some of this money to help the teachers by giving them some free braille books to use with their students.



Number Distributed: In 2016, 4225 free braille books were distributed to teachers in CA, NV, UT, CO, AZ, NM, AL, OK, AR, LA, MS, MI, and various summer school programs across the country.

One teacher said this about the program: "Thank you for the wonderful braille books! My students were truly excited to receive them and couldn't wait to choose a book to read. Due to your generosity the children will have access to additional braille books at their reading level. Again thank you for providing such a wealth of braille literature to the students. 



Volunteer Spotlight

Retired educator still serving blind children

When Kathy Donagrandi was a teenager, she took a volunteer job at a camp for children with special needs.

She came home after the first day and told her mother: "It was awful. It hurt my heart." Her mother said she didn't have to go back.

But the next day, she did. "There was something about those children that I realized," she said. "They were children. They were different, but they were like the children in my neighborhood."

Kathy Donagrandi arrives at Seedlings with books she's brailled at home. She is accompanied by granddaughters Emma and Anna.

That realization – that children with special needs are children first - has shaped Kathy's life. She earned bachelor's and master's degrees in teaching students who are visually and mentally impaired from Eastern Michigan University, and then spent 44 years working in special education at Livonia Public Schools.

She started out transcribing students' assignments into braille so the students could read them. and students' brailled homework into print so the teachers could grade it. She retired in January 2015 as administrator of student services.

About a year later, she became Seedlings' newest volunteer.

As a retiree, Kathy could have volunteered anywhere. "There are so many places that want your time and your money," she said. But she chose Seedlings, she said, not only because of her life's passion but because of founder/director Debra Bonde.

As a member of Seedlings' board from 1988 to 1995, including time as president, Kathy knows Debra runs a well-managed non-profit. Of every \$1 donated, 91 cents goes into book production, not overhead costs. "All the money

Seedlings, which Debra started 32 years ago, changed all that by selling books at an average price of only \$10 a book, about half the cost to produce them, and publishing a catalog where parents and grandparents could select books to give as gifts to blind children.

Children who are visually impaired need to have books just like sighted children do, Kathy said. "It's freeing for them not to have to depend on someone reading to them."

Kathy and Debra met during Seedlings' early years when Seedlings' office was in Debra's basement in Detroit. Kathy helped Seedlings find its first Livonia home in the old Bentley High School.

Besides serving on Seedlings' board, Kathy participated in fund-

raisers and helped spread the word about Seedlings. She often makes a donation to have a book inscribed in someone's name to honor or remember them. Now, some of those people do the same for others.

Kathy always knew she'd come back to Seedlings to volunteer after retiring. "There was no organization I would be more comfortable with," she said.




